

WHAT INDEX GIVES YOU EXPOSURE TO MICRO-CAP COMPANIES WITH A HISTORICAL ANNUAL GROWTH RATE OF **33.63%**?

CONSIDER THE RICHMOND CLUB INDEX

The Richmond Club Index (RCI) tracks the performance of high growth small-cap companies.

History

In July 2005, the Richmond Club Corp. created the Richmond Club Index as a way to track the performance of the companies it was selecting to present at its member luncheon events.

The Richmond Club is celebrating its 10th year of providing brokers, fund managers and analyst with insight into under noticed companies that are trading at significantly below their fair market value relative to their peers due to a lack of investor exposure. Companies in the Richmond Club Index must meet the following criteria:

- 1) Management must be poised for significant growth over the next twelve months,
- 2) Trade at significantly less than fair market value relative to their peers,
- 3) Have an excellent chance to grow their stock price by 50% or more over the next twelve months and
- 4) Have an investor relations program in place.

The Richmond Club helps its index listed companies increase their market-cap to attain a fair market valuation relative to their peers by supplying these companies with the missing ingredient—Investor exposure. The Richmond Club does this by profiling these companies to investors through: luncheon events, press releases, internet exposure and internet video-PowerPoint presentations.

Here is a summary of the basic rules that the Richmond Club index has been using:

- Selected companies, all Richmond Club clients, are added to the index the first of the following month after signing and remain in until the first of the month after the duration of the Richmond Club Investor Exposure contract.
- To remain in the index at the end of contract, a company must have grown the value of its business faster than its stock price.
- At the end of each month the index is "re-balanced" to include the new companies being added to the index and to exclude those that have been removed. The index is an equal weighted index.

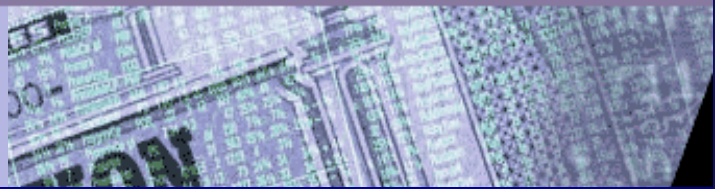

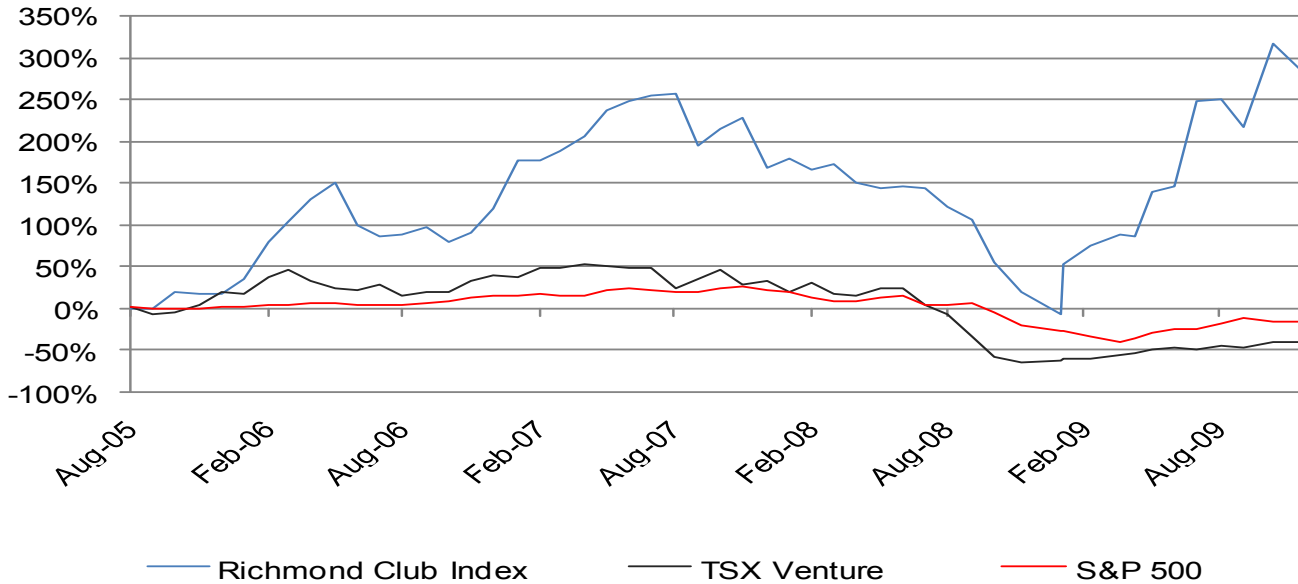
